






- Aim of partnerships is to connect regional ecosystems based on S3 priorities and similar value chains
- Connecting business needs and challenges and working with regional intermediaries such as clusters and industrial federations
- Purpose is to progress toward co-investment projects
- But also strengthen other forms of interregional cooperation and policy alignment

Developing Industrial Modernisation Cooperation Investment
Protocols building on four types of investment projects







Examples

5 types of ReConfirm investment partnerships

- New production lines
 - Develop new production procedures to improve efficiency and profitability
- Shared training facilities
 - Work together to develop a shared facility and content for training entrepreneurs or researchers
- **■** Common capacity building
 - Equip businesses and entrepreneurs with the skills to develop, manage, implement and evaluate solutions to societal challenges
- Shared technology centres
 - Launch a technology centre with public and private organisations to undertake product research and innovation
- Research and development (R&D) cooperation
 - Build cooperation in R&D as a platform for improved policy coordination, new networking activities and for sharing knowledge and innovation



Therefore S3P are different from Interreg Europe but complementarities can be seen and many opportunities for connecting initiatives and developing long term and sustainable cooperation: some 19 IRE projects from Calls 1-2 deemed to have a good fit with S3P such as NMP-REG, STEPHANIE S3CHEM... http://s3platform.jrc.ec.europa.eu/-/s3p-industry-and-interreg-europe-working-for-industrial-modernisation

- Technologies: nanotechnology, industrial biotechnology, advanced materials, photonics, advanced manufacturing.
- Industries: Food, Textile, Chemical
- Cross thematic Horizontal issues: via clusters for example ClusterFy, Clusterix2.0, S34Growth ...



Interreg Europe Policy Brief: Towards Synergies between S3 Industry Partnerships and Interreg Europe Projects, highlighted the following opportunities:

- Sharing methodological tools (accelerate learning and exchange)
- Thematic or sector-based cooperation (see above)
- Developing Financial Instruments and preparing for Interregional Innovation Co-investments (Article 70 ... and future DG Regio interregional innovation investment tools
- Promoting business and SME engagement (engaging with value chain stakeholders and intermediaries such as clusters)



The IRE Policy brief concludes with four concrete suggestions for enhancing synergies between the two project communities:

- Sharing of mapping and/or scoping methodologies to enhance policy makers bottom up knowledge of regional ecosystems and create the conditions for European level cooperation and scale up, for example EDP;
- Implement thematic or sector level working groups to build linkages between similar stakeholder groups and construct European level value chains to support and accelerate industrial transformation;
- Share experiences regarding the engagement of businesses (working via clusters) and notably SMEs to ensure the robustness of policy options and project ideas; and
- Collect and share experiences of interregional funding and governance models to support overall project implementation opportunities.

- Horizon 2020 INNOSUP 01 providing cascade funding for interregional innovation projects led by SMEs/RTO etc and facilitated by cluster networks ... Neptune in Water, Impact Connected Car, Iot4 Industry, DIVA and VIDA food ...

Examples of Cooperation Success Stories



- Strengthening mapping: MedTech S3P and MedTech for Europe IRE, both led by French Region Auvergne Rhone Alpes
- Broadening Partnership: ClusSport and Sport4Europe IRE, developing value chain coverage by adding new partners
- Working with key intermediaries: Clusters as facilitators, experiences of S3-European Strategic Cluster Partnerships, supported by DG GROW-COSME, two such partnerships working within MedTech4Europe S3P

Examples of Cooperation Success Stories



- Facilitation by ReConfirm: EWRC Workshop in which HoCare IRE presented it's action plan implementation, notably means to secure ERDF funding for launching pilot project in Cyprus.
- Project and Partnership Networking supported by Interreg Europe: Lapland April 2018
- Showcasing investment ideas: S3P Steering Committee meeting Bilbao November 2018, five partnerships presented their ideas (Sport, Chemical, Photonics ...) Also interaction with two other S3 platforms Energy and AgriFood

Challenges for Implementing Interregional investment projects



It is not easy! Challenges encountered include:

- Alignment of funding programmes
- Deploying cross-border initiatives and associated funding
- Spending money in other regions- Lack of bespoke financial tools
- Robustness of business case
- Connecting innovation ecosystems seek faciltators
- Legal issues and political dimension
- Time factor ...
- Variety of projects (cooperation versus co-investment)
- Lessons from Interreg Europe Action Plan implementation can help with some aspects notably interregional cooperation
- Clusters valuable actors for macro region level cooperation and value chain analysis

Pursuing Cooperation Opportunities




